



Dress Code Policy

Credit Union 1 strives to project a professional image. The first impression can be a powerful way to encourage current and potential members to trust Credit Union 1 with all their financial needs. Employees are encouraged to “dress for success.”

Men

Dress pants or suits worn with the following:

- Button down dress shirt with a tie. A sport coat is optional.
- Sweater or sweater vest with button down dress shirt or turtleneck. If V-neck, a tie must be worn.
- Dress shoes with socks
- No sport shirts (i.e., polos)

Women

- Dresses, suits or pantsuits
- Skirts or dress pants with professional looking blouse, sweater or jacket
- Skirts and dresses must be of professional length
- Gauchos (full style) must be worn with a dress blouse and/or jacket
- Dress shoes, dress sandals or dress boots are to be worn with appropriate foot/leg wear
- No jumpsuits, sundresses or Capri-length pants
- Blouses must be at least to the edge of your shoulder; No tank tops or spaghetti straps
- No casual shirts worn as a layered look

Additional guidelines:

- No denim
- Low-cut, tight or revealing clothing that at anytime reveals cleavage, back, chest, stomach or underwear is not appropriate and unacceptable.
- Clothing is not to be torn, tattered, worn, wrinkled or stained.
- Facial jewelry such as eyebrow, nose or lip rings, excessive earrings, plugs, tongue studs and tattoos are not professionally appropriate and must not be worn or visible during business hours. Torso body piercing with visible jewelry or jewelry that can be seen through or under clothing must not be worn during business hours.
- Extreme hair styles or colors are not appropriate in a business professional environment (purple, blue, green, pink, etc., as well as hats, bandanas, etc.) and are not permitted to be worn during working hours. Hair, beards and mustaches must be kept professionally neat and clean.
