Eligibility through your support of the Credit Union 1 Educational Development Association, Inc. ("CU1EDA")

To join Credit Union 1 (CU1), you must be eligible through one of our fields of membership. By submitting your application for membership, you confirm that you are eligible through one of the following means:

- 1. You are an employee or spouse of an employee in a Select Employer Group; or
- 2. You have a **Family Member** that is an existing member of CU1; or
- 3. You live, work or worship within the boundaries of one of our Community Charters; or
- 4. You are a **CU1 Employee**.

If you are not eligible for membership through one of the four above-described means, you have the option to become a member of the CU1EDA by making a \$5.00 donation to the CU1EDA, which then makes you eligible for membership in Credit Union 1. The CU1EDA is a non-profit corporation with a mission to raise funds for communities, schools and individuals to provide for educational needs including, but not limited to, grants, schoolarships, school supplies, and training.

What does this mean for you?

If you choose to become eligible for membership in CU1 by becoming a member of CU1EDA, CU1 will pay the \$5 donation on your behalf to the CU1EDA and share your name and contact information with CU1EDA. Thereafter, you will need a minimum of \$5.00 to open your account online with CU1. The \$5 is your \$5 required minimum membership share in CU1. Membership in CU1 requires you to maintain the \$5.00 membership share, which we place on hold in your savings account. If you decide you no longer want to be a member of CU1, the \$5.00 share will be returned to you at account closure.
